BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 41-9-870 of the Code of Alabama

12 1975, is amended to read as follows:

"\$41-9-870.

"(a) The Alabama Peace Officers' Hall of Fame Board is hereby created and established. The board shall be composed of seven law enforcement officers. Any board member serving on the effective date of the act adding this language shall serve a term of four years commencing from that date, and thereafter, all board members shall be appointed as herein provided and shall serve a term of office of four years. Each two years the board shall elect one of its members to serve as chair. The board members shall be appointed as follows, viz: One member shall be appointed from the Alabama Peace Officers' Association; one member shall be appointed from the Alabama Sheriffs' Association; one member shall be appointed from the

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| 2 | the Alabama League of Municipalities; one member shall be |
