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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Each tax assessor or revenue commissioner shall mail a reminder to each taxpayer before the 64th birthday of the taxpayer reminding him or her that on or after his or her 65th birthday, but not before the 63rd birthday he or she is eligible to claim an exemption from certain state or county property taxes on his or her homestead.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
