 - (5) A valid government issued picture identification of parent or parents, such as a passport or driver's license.

- (c) The State Registrar shall develop any necessary
 forms for adoptive parents to submit in order to request a
 Certificate of Foreign Birth.
- 17 Section 3. This act shall be known as Karina's Law.
