To amend Section 30-3-194 of the Code of Alabama

1975, relating to providing the Social Security number for

issuance or renewal of licenses; to repeal the requirement for

providing the Social Security number for license renewal.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 30-3-194 of the Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

"\$30-3-194**.**

- "(a) Any agency charged with the administration of any law concerning the issuance or renewal of a license, certificate, permit, or other authorization to drive a private or commercial motor vehicle or to engage in a profession, occupation, or recreational, sporting, or commercial activity shall require all applicants for issuance or renewal of the license, certificate, permit, or other authorization to provide the applicant's Social Security number to the agency, which agency shall record the Social Security number on the application and related records maintained by the agency.
- "(b) All divorce decrees, support orders, and paternity determinations issued, and all paternity acknowledgments made, shall include in the records the Social Security number of each party subject to the decree, order, determination, or acknowledgement. The Social Security number of each party subject to a divorce shall be included in the divorce certificate filed in the Office of Vital Statistics.
- "(c) The Social Security number of both parties to the marriage shall be collected by those parties issuing a

marriage license and shall appear on the license and 1 2 certificate sent to the Office of Vital Statistics. "(d) The Office of Vital Statistics shall collect 3 the Social Security number of the deceased individual and place the number on the death certificate. 5 "(e) Any agency charged with the duty to record an 6 7 individual's Social Security number shall provide the individual's Social Security number to the state Title IV-D 8 agency at the agency's request for the purpose of 9 10 administering the child support program." Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 11 12 first day of the third month following its passage and

approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
