8 SYNOPSIS: This bill would propose an amendment to the  
9 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, relating to  
10 Baldwin County, to provide that, notwithstanding  
11 any other law or agreement to the contrary, no  
12 municipality located wholly or partially within  
13 Baldwin County shall have or exercise any police  
14 jurisdiction or any zoning, planning, subdivision,  
15 or other land use jurisdiction beyond the corporate  
16 limits of the municipality.

18 A BILL  
19 TO BE ENTITLED

22 To propose an amendment to the Constitution of  
23 Alabama of 1901, relating to Baldwin County, to provide that,  
24 notwithstanding any other law or agreement to the contrary, no  
25 municipality located wholly or partially within Baldwin County  
26 shall have or exercise any police jurisdiction or any zoning,

1 planning, subdivision, or other land use jurisdiction beyond  
2 the corporate limits of the municipality.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

4 Section 1. The following amendment to the  
5 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become  
6 valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of  
7 this act are fulfilled:

8 PROPOSED AMENDMENT

9 Notwithstanding any other law or agreement to the  
10 contrary, no municipality located wholly or partially within  
11 Baldwin County shall have or exercise any police jurisdiction  
12 or any zoning, planning, subdivision, or other land use  
13 jurisdiction beyond the corporate limits of the municipality.

14 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment  
15 shall be held in accordance with Amendment 555 to the  
16 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section  
17 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of  
18 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this  
19 state.

20 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall  
21 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional  
22 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the  
23 following description of the substance or subject matter of  
24 the proposed constitutional amendment:

25 "Relating to Baldwin County, proposing an amendment  
26 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to provide that,  
27 notwithstanding any other law or agreement to the contrary, no

1 municipality located wholly or partially within Baldwin County  
2 shall have or exercise any police jurisdiction or any zoning,  
3 planning, subdivision, or other land use jurisdiction beyond  
4 the corporate limits of the municipality.

7 language:
