3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of this act are fulfilled:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Notwithstanding any other law or agreement to the contrary, no municipality located wholly or partially within Baldwin County shall have or exercise any police jurisdiction or any zoning, planning, subdivision, or other land use jurisdiction beyond the corporate limits of the municipality.

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Amendment 555 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this state.

Section 3. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the following description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed constitutional amendment:

"Relating to Baldwin County, proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to provide that, notwithstanding any other law or agreement to the contrary, no
