## 4 ENROLLED, An Act,

Relating to recreational park trailers; to require recreational park trailers to be constructed in compliance with standards of the American National Standards Institute and to be subject to independent third-party inspections.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

"recreational park trailer" is a transportable unit that has a body width not exceeding 14 feet and which is built on a single chassis and is designed to provide seasonal or temporary living quarters when connected to utilities necessary for operation of installed fixtures and appliances. The total area of the unit in a setup mode, when measured from the exterior surface of the exterior stud walls at the level of maximum dimensions, not including any bay window, may not exceed 400 square feet when constructed to ANSI A-119.5 standards. The length of a recreational park trailer means the distance from the exterior of the front of the body nearest to the drawbar and coupling mechanism to the exterior of the rear of the body at the opposite end of the body including any protrusions.

- Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
