27	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. A local board of education may allow any person employed as school security personnel or as a school resource officer by the board to carry a firearm while on duty if the employee meets the following qualifications that he or she:

6 (1) Has attended 16 hours of firearm training in a 7 program approved by the Alabama Peace Officers Standards and 8 Training Commission.

9 (2) Annually completes and passes the firearm 10 re-qualification required of law enforcement officers by the 11 Alabama Peace Officers Standards and Training Commission.

12 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 13 first day of the third month following its passage and 14 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
