27	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

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Section 1. (a) Any licensed architect, professional engineer, or professional land surveyor engaged by the owner of a particular piece or parcel of ground to perform architectural, engineering, or land surveying services shall have a lien against the particular piece or parcel of ground with respect to which the services were rendered when work on the piece or parcel of ground has not begun.

8 (b) A written statement of the claim shall be filed 9 for registry with the judge of probate of the county in which 10 the immovable property is located within 90 days of the date 11 of the services and shall not be effective as to third persons 12 until such time as the statement of the claim is filed, but 13 thereafter shall be a first lien and privilege superior to any 14 lien, privilege, or mortgage subsequently recorded.

15 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 16 first day of the third month following its passage and 17 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.

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
