SB476 1 2 3 With Notice and Proof 4 5 6 ENROLLED, An Act, Relating to Clay County; to amend Sections 7 8 45-14-244.02 and 45-14-244.05, Code of Alabama 1975; to add a new Section 45-14-244.04 to the Code of Alabama 1975, as 9 repealed by Act 2010-401, 2010 Regular Session (Acts 2010, p. 10 11 660); to further provide for the distribution of the tobacco 12 tax. 13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA: 14 Section 1. Sections 45-14-244.02 and 45-14-244.05, 15 Code of Alabama 1975, are amended to read as follows: "§45-14-244.02. 16 17 "It shall be unlawful for any dealer, storer, or 18 distributor engaged in or continuing in the business in Clay 19 County for which the tax is levied to fail or refuse to add to 20 the sales price and collect from the purchaser the amount due 21 to Clay County on account of the tax herein provided, to 22 refund or offer to refund all or any part of the amount 23 collected or absorbed, or advertise directly or indirectly, 24 the absorption of the tax or any portion thereof. Any person, 25 firm, corporation, club, or association violating this section

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shall be subject to a civil penalty of not less than
twenty-five dollars (\$25) nor more than five hundred dollars
(\$500). Each act in violation of this section shall constitute
a separate offense.

5 "(1) The State Department of Revenue may collect all 6 taxes levied pursuant to this part at the same time and in the 7 same manner as state sales and use taxes are collected.

8 "(2) The tax levied herein shall be paid by affixing 9 stamps that are required for the payment of the tax imposed by 10 Sections 40-25-1 to 40-25-28, inclusive.

"(3) The county shall, in conjunction with the District Community Service Grant Authority, contract with the State Department of Revenue to purchase stamps to be affixed. The department may have the same duties relative to the preparation and sale of stamps to evidence the payment of the tax that it has relative to the preparation and sale of stamps under Sections 40-25-1 to 40-25-28, inclusive.

"(4) In accordance with Section 40-25-2(q), in the 18 19 event the aforementioned tobacco stamps are not available for 20 affixing to tobacco products packages and containers, or by 21 the authority of a duly promulgated regulation eliminating the 22 requirement of affixing county tobacco stamps, the entity, 23 including the Commissioner of the Department of Revenue, may 24 require a monthly report in lieu of stamps to report the 25 amount of tax due. The monthly report shall be in a form

approved by the commissioner and adopted by the department
under the Alabama Administrative Procedure Act, Chapter 22,
Title 41.

5 "(a) The proceeds from the tax authorized, less two 6 percent of the actual cost of collection, which shall be 7 retained by the Department of Revenue, shall be distributed to 8 the Clay County General Fund to be expended as follows:

9 "(1) Thirty-five percent of the proceeds shall be 10 distributed to the Alabama Forestry Commission to be utilized 11 for fire protection in the county, as provided in subsection 12 (b).

"(2) Twenty-five percent of the proceeds shall be
distributed to the Clay County Industrial Development Council.

15 "(3) Twenty-five percent of the proceeds shall be 16 distributed to the District Community Service Grant Authority 17 to be allocated by the authority.

18 "(4) Fifteen percent shall be distributed to the 19 Citizens for the Welfare of Animals in Clay County to be used 20 for small animal control on a countywide basis. The Citizens 21 for the Welfare of Animals in Clay County may use the funds to 22 contract with an adjoining county to provide animal shelter 23 services.

24 "(b) The funds distributed to the Alabama Forestry25 Commission shall be payable on a quarterly or monthly basis

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and will be expended solely for purposes of fire protection, 1 2 prevention, and fire safety education in order to encourage a 3 strong volunteer firefighters' network in Clay County. The proceeds shall be distributed to volunteer fire departments in 4 5 the county as determined by rules and regulations set up by 6 the Alabama Forestry Commission and the Clay County Volunteer 7 Firefighters Association on an equal basis, share and share 8 alike. None of the proceeds shall be used for salaries nor to 9 pay members for any performance of duties associated with the 10 department. Any member fire department which fails to meet the 11 standards and criteria shall be denied its share of the 12 funding. The association shall give noncomplying member fire 13 departments proper notice of all deficiencies and a reasonable 14 time period to correct the deficiencies before any funds shall 15 be denied."

Section 2. Section 45-14-244.04, as repealed by Act 2010-401, 2010 Regular Session (Acts 2010, p. 660), is added to the Code of Alabama 1975, to read as follows:

19 There is hereby created the District Community 20 Service Grant Authority consisting of the Senator from Senate 21 District 13 and the House members from House Districts 37 and 22 38. The District Community Service Grant Authority shall 23 allocate funds distributed to the authority.

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Section 3. This act shall become effective on the
first day of the second month following its passage and
approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
