4 ENROLLED, An Act,

5 To amend Section 34-22-61 of the Code of Alabama
6 1975, relating to the Board of Optometric Scholarship Awards,
7 to specify that funds of the board would not revert at the end
8 of the fiscal year.

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

10 Section 1. Section 34-22-61 of the Code of Alabama
11 1975, is amended to read as follows:

12 "§34-22-61.

13 "(a) The Board of Optometric Scholarship Awards
14 shall have power and authority to make reasonable rules and
15 regulations not inconsistent with the laws of this state, as
16 may be necessary for the regulation of its proceedings and for
17 the discharge of the duties imposed upon it. The board shall
18 receive and review all applications for scholarship loans and
19 awards; shall make a careful and thorough investigation of the
20 ability and character and qualifications of each applicant;
21 and shall be responsible for the further administration of the
22 scholarship program subject to the provisions of this article.

23 "(b) Any appropriation made to the Board of
24 Optometric Scholarship Awards or otherwise received by the

1 board remaining at the end of any fiscal year shall remain
2 with the board and shall not revert to any other fund."

3 Section 2. This act shall become effective
4 immediately following its passage and approval by the
5 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
