19	To amend Section 14-3-58, Code of Alabama 1975,

23	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
24	Section 1. Section 14-3-58, Code of Alabama 1975, is
25	amended to read as follows:
26	<b>"</b> \$14-3-58

1	"(a) This act shall be known as the "Joel Willmore
2	Act."
3	" <u>(b)</u> Whenever <del>any convict</del> <u>an inmate</u> escapes <u>from a</u>
4	penal facility of the Department of Corrections, as defined in
5	subdivision (3) of subsection (b) of Section 13A-10-30, it
6	shall be the duty of the Board of Corrections department to
7	take all proper measures for his or her apprehension, and for
8	that purpose, it must forthwith shall notify the following
9	within 12 hours of the escape:
10	"(1) communicate to the Governor the fact of such
11	escape, The Governor.
12	"(2) The Department of Public Safety.
13	"(3) The sheriff of the county where the escape
14	occurred.
15	"(4) The chief of police where the escape occurred,
16	if the escape occurred within a municipality.
17	"(5) The sheriff of the county where the last
18	conviction of the escapee occurred.
19	"(6) The chief of police where the last conviction
20	of the escapee occurred, if the conviction occurred within a
21	municipality.
22	"(7) The sheriff of the county where the convict's
23	home of record is located.
24	"(8) The chief of police where the convict's home of
25	record is located, if the location is within a municipality.

1	"(9) All electronic media outlets broadcasting from
2	within a radius of 75 miles from where the escape occurred,
3	including all radio and television stations.
4	"(c) The notification required in subsection (b)

"(c) The notification required in subsection (b) shall include the time when and the circumstances under which it the escape was effected, together with a particular description of the convict inmate, including a copy of the inmate's most recent mug shot, and in what county convicted and for what offense and when;

"(d) In addition to the requirements set forth in subsections (b) and (c), the department shall post a notification on its website of the escape. The notification shall include the time when and the circumstances under which the escape was effected, together with a particular description of the inmate, including a copy of the inmate's most recent mug shot, and in what county convicted and for what offense and when.

"(e) The Director of Central Records of the department shall enter the inmate into the National Crime Information Center within 12 hours of the inmate's escape.

"(f) The Department of Corrections and the board shall offer a reward, not exceeding \$400.00 four hundred dollars (\$400), for the apprehension of such the state convict, to be paid out of the proceeds of the labor of convicts inmates in the State Treasury. But no warrant shall be issued for the payment of any such reward unless there is filed in the office of the Department of Finance the

4	Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
5	first day of the third month following its passage and
6	approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
