8	SYNOPSIS: Under current law, the State Purchasing
9	Division of the Department of Finance is not
10	required to maintain a statewide database of each
11	request for a bid or proposal for a public contract
12	by the State of Alabama, a political subdivision,
13	an agency, board, commission, or department of the
14	state, the State Board of Education, a public
15	college or trade school, or a public university.
16	This bill would require the State Purchasing
17	Division of the Department of Finance to maintain a
18	statewide database for each request for a bid or
19	proposal by the State of Alabama, a political
20	subdivision, an agency, board, commission, or
21	department of the state, the State Board of
22	Education, a public college or trade school, or a
23	public university for public contracts.

26	TO BE ENTITLED
27	AN ACT

To require the State Purchasing Division of the Department of Finance to maintain a statewide database of each request for a bid or proposal for a public contract by the State of Alabama, a political subdivision, an agency, board, commission, or department of the state, the State Board of Education, a public college or trade school, or a public university.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) The State Purchasing Division of the Department of Finance shall establish and maintain and post on the Internet a statewide database of each request for a bid or proposal for a public contract by the State of Alabama, a political subdivision, an agency, board, commission, or department of the state, the State Board of Education, a public college or trade school, or a public university.

- (b) The database shall be a public record and may be viewed by any citizen, either in person or via the Internet.

 The department shall make its database accessible through the Internet.
- (c) Each request for a bid or proposal shall remain available on the website until the last posting date required by law has expired.
- (d) There shall not be a charge for access to the database.
