Willful conduct means a 14 purpose or intent or design to injure another and if a 15 contractor, the officers, directors, agents, or employees of the contractor, with knowledge of the danger or peril to 16 17 another, consciously pursue a course of conduct with a design, intent, and purpose of inflicting injury, then they shall be 18 quilty of willful conduct. 19

20 Section 2. This act shall only apply to a cause of 21 action occurring on and after the effective date of this act. 22 Section 3. This act shall become effective 23 immediately following its passage and approval by the 24 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
