18	" <u>(a)</u> The authority shall have the right to acquire
19	by eminent domain any property, real or personal, which it may
20	deem necessary to carry out the purposes of this article,
21	after the adoption by it of a resolution declaring that the
22	acquisition of the property described therein is in the public
23	interest and necessary for public use. The authority may
24	exercise the power of eminent domain pursuant to the
25	provisions of Title 18. Property already devoted to a public
26	use may be acquired; provided, that no property belonging to
27	any city within the boundaries of the authority, or to any

1 government, may be acquired without its consent, and that no
2 property belonging to a public utility corporation may be
3 acquired without the approval of the Public Service Commission
4 or other body having regulatory power over such corporation.

"(b) In Class 3 municipalities, except a Class 3 5 municipality organized under Act 618 of the 1973 Regular 6 7 Session, the authority may purchase real property only after notice of intent to purchase the property is given to 8 surrounding property owners. Notice of the proposed purchase 9 10 in such Class 3 municipalities shall be sent via first class 11 mail to each residential and business address within 500 300 12 yards of the property proposed to be purchased not less than 13 30 days prior to execution of any binding agreement to 14 purchase the property."

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
