Section 2. Section 13A-5-12.1 of the Code of Alabama 12 1975, is repealed. This act shall not be interpreted to affect 13 any violation of a municipal ordinance based on an offense 14 prior to the effective date of this act.

Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
