24	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
25	Section 1. (a) For the purposes of this act, the
26	following terms shall have the following meanings:

1 (1) ECONOMIC INCENTIVE. Any direct price subsidy
2 made available by the state directly to support the purchase
3 of raw forest products, not to include any benefit available
4 under statutorily provided programs.

- (2) RAW FOREST PRODUCT. Any raw material harvested or recovered from forest wood or wood waste at its initial conversion.
- (b) Any economic incentive granted on or after July 1, 2011, to any person, company, partnership, or other entity engaged in the commercial use of raw forest products shall be extended equitably to all users of raw forest products in this state so as to establish and maintain parity within that segment of the economy.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on July
1, 2011, following its passage and approval by the Governor,
or its otherwise becoming law.
