15	grants of money authorized in Section 41-10-26. The grantees
16	may use the grants authorized in that section for any of the
17	following purposes:
18	"(1) The making of surveys to determine the location
19	of suitable industrial sites in the locality of the grantee.
20	"(2) The making of surveys to determine the
21	availability of labor in the locality of the grantee and to
22	classify such labor in terms of skills and educational level.
23	"(3) The preparation of industrial sites.
24	"(4) Any combination of any of the foregoing which
25	the grantees consider appropriate and necessary for the

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- "(b) Every grant of money made by the authority pursuant to Section 41-10-26 shall be made subject to the following terms and conditions, which are hereby declared to be legally enforceable in any court of competent jurisdiction:
- "(1) No part of any such grant or grants shall be used with respect to the preparation of industrial sites in excess of one and one-half percent of the amount that it is anticipated will be spent for the construction and equipment of the facilities that will occupy the said industrial sites as such anticipated amount shall be certified to the authority by the architect or engineer for the facilities to be constructed and equipped or by the chief executive officer of the grantee.
- "(2) The authority shall have power to audit the disbursements by the grantee from such grant or grants.
- "(3) Any other appropriate terms and conditions to facilitate the enforcement of the foregoing provisions of this subsection."
- Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
