## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Any municipality that has adopted zoning and zoning regulations within its corporate limits, by duly enacted ordinance, may zone and divide the territory in its police jurisdiction into similar zones and districts as are established within the corporate limits of the municipality. The municipality may regulate zoning and zoning procedures and requirements in its police jurisdiction in the same manner and under the same controls and under the same statutory authority as provided for within the corporate limits.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
