The 3 4 authority may exercise the power of eminent domain pursuant to 5 the provisions of Title 18. Property already devoted to a 6 public use may be acquired; provided, that no property 7 belonging to any city within the boundaries of the authority, or to any government, may be acquired without its consent, and 8 that no property belonging to a public utility corporation may 9 10 be acquired without the approval of the Public Service 11 Commission or other body having regulatory power over such 12 corporation." Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 13 14 first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law. 15
