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4 ENROLLED, An Act,

5 Relating to the Board of Pharmacy; to authorize the
6 board to establish by rule protocols permitting a retail
7 pharmacy to repackage, relabel, and store non-controlled
8 legend drugs for a patient residing in a residential care
9 facility that does not have a pharmacy.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

11 Section 1. (a) The Board of Pharmacy may establish
12 by rule protocols allowing a pharmacy in possession of a
13 current retail pharmacy permit to repackage, relabel, and
14 store any non-controlled legend drug for a patient residing in
15 a residential care facility which does not have a pharmacy
16 located on the premises.

17 (b) For purposes of this section, a residential care
18 facility means any of the following:

- 19 (1) A convalescent home.
20 (2) A nursing home.
21 (3) An extended care facility.
22 (4) A mental health or psychiatric facility.
23 (5) A rehabilitation facility.
24 (6) A developmental disability center.
25 (7) An assisted living facility.

1 (8) A speciality care assisted living facility.

2 Section 2. This act shall become effective
3 immediately following its passage and approval by the
4 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
