1 in the classified service of the county to an unclassified 2 position shall be a condition of employment for appointment made after the effective date of such county employee to an 3 4 unclassified position; to provide that persons not previously employees of the county at the time of their appointment to 5 6 unclassified positions as provided for in the act shall become 7 unclassified employees of the county; and to provide that persons employed as unclassified employees shall be eligible 8 for county employee benefits, including, but not limited to, 9 10 retirement benefits, as shall otherwise be provided for county 11 employees.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. This act shall apply only to JeffersonCounty.

Section 2. (a) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, persons holding any of the following positions in the employment of Jefferson County shall be employed at-will as unclassified employees and are not subject to the county merit system:

20 (1) Any attorney in the office of the county21 attorney.

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(2) The chief financial officer of the county.

23 (3) County department and agency heads and their24 chief deputies.

(4) Any person employed in the county unclassifiedexecutive service.

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1 (b) The Personnel Board of Jefferson County may 2 designate or create positions in the county unclassified 3 executive service upon recommendation or request of the county 4 commission.

(c) A person employed in an unclassified position 5 6 listed in subdivisions (1) to (4), inclusive, of subsection 7 (a) shall serve at the pleasure of the applicable appointing authority, who shall set the rate of compensation of the 8 9 unclassified employee, with the subsequent approval of a 10 majority of the county commission at a commission meeting. A person employed in an unclassified position shall have no 11 12 rights of appeal under the enabling act of the Personnel Board of Jefferson County, Act 248 of the Alabama Legislature of 13 14 1945, p. 376, as amended, and no property interest in an unclassified position. 15

(d) In the event that an employee in the classified 16 17 service is appointed to and accepts an unclassified position listed in subdivisions (1) to (4), inclusive, of subsection 18 (a), such employee may return to the classified service 19 following any termination without cause from the unclassified 20 21 appointment, at the same job classification from which such 22 employee was appointed, provided that such a vacant position 23 exists.

(e) For purposes of subsection (d), "cause" includesany of the following reasons:

(1) The employee was at the time of his or her
 appointment or has since become ineligible to be employed by

1 the county because the employee failed to meet the minimum 2 job-related qualifications for his or her position.

3 (2) Malfeasance, misfeasance, or nonfeasance in
4 employment.

5 (3) Conviction of a felony crime or of a misdemeanor
6 involving moral turpitude.

7 (4) Failure to perform his or her duties as provided
8 by this act in an honorable, competent, and reasonably
9 efficient manner.

10 (5) He or she becomes morally, physically, or11 mentally unfit to act on behalf of the county.

12 (f) No person employed in the classified service as 13 a department or agency head or chief deputy before the effective date of this act shall be converted to an 14 15 unclassified employee described in subdivisions (1) to (4), inclusive, of subsection (a), unless the person voluntarily 16 17 elects the conversion with the approval of the personnel board and the appointing authority. Notwithstanding the foregoing, a 18 conversion to an unclassified employee status shall be a 19 condition of employment for any appointment to an unclassified 20 21 position listed in subdivisions (1) to (4), inclusive, of subsection (a) made on or after the effective date of this 22 23 act. Any noncounty employee appointed to an unclassified 24 position listed in subdivisions (1) to (4), inclusive, of subsection (a) on or after the effective date of this act, by 25 26 virtue of the appointment, shall be an unclassified nonmerit 27 system employee of Jefferson County.

(g) A person employed in an unclassified position
listed in subdivisions (1) to (4), inclusive, of subsection
(a) may receive the same benefits, including, but not limited
to, retirement benefits, as are available to classified county
employees unless that person elects in writing to forfeit his
or her participation.
Section 3. All laws or parts of laws which conflict

8 with this act are repealed.

9 Section 4. This act shall become effective 10 immediately following its passage and approval by the 11 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
