The following amendment to the 9 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, is proposed and 10 shall become valid as a part thereof when approved by a 11 majority of the qualified electors voting thereon and in 12 accordance with Sections 284, 285, and 287 of the Constitution 13 of Alabama of 1901, as amended:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

15 The county-by-county reappraisal of all Class II and Class III real property in the State of Alabama which is 16 17 conducted and supervised by the Department of Revenue pursuant to Chapter 7 of Title 40, Code of Alabama 1975, shall not be 18 conducted more often than once every four years, provided that 19 20 the level of equalization for a particular county falls 21 between 90 percent and 105 percent with a coefficient of dispersion of no greater than 20 as determined by an annual 22 23 sales ratio study conducted by the Department of Revenue.

24 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment 25 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the 26 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284 27 and 285 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of

Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this
state.

3 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall 4 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional 5 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the 6 following description of the substance or subject matter of 7 the proposed constitutional amendment:

"Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of 8 Alabama of 1901, to provide that Class II and Class III real 9 10 property would not be subject to reappraisal more often than 11 once every four years, provided that the level of equalization 12 for a particular county falls between 90 percent and 105 13 percent with a coefficient of dispersion of no greater than 20 14 as determined by an annual sales ratio study conducted by the 15 Department of Revenue."
