			LEGISLATURE	

Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of this act are fulfilled:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Every employee of the City of Prichard may participate in either the Employees' Retirement System of Alabama or in the municipal retirement system in the same manner and upon the same terms and conditions as may be specified by law for any other employee in the same retirement system. Any employee of the City of Prichard at the time of ratification of this amendment may purchase service credit in the Employees' Retirement System retroactive for five years, provided the employee makes the election within one year of the ratification of the amendment.

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Amendment 555 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this state.

Section 3. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the following description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed constitutional amendment:
