8 Section 1. The Legislature finds that Act 2009-722 generally became effective May 21, 2009, upon the approval of 9 the Governor. The Legislature finds that certain otherwise 10 11 qualifying projects were in the development stages under 12 existing law prior to the certain amendments in Act 2009-722. 13 The Legislature desires to have a transition period for the 14 approval of certain projects based on certain requirements 15 under existing law before the effective date of Act 2009-722.

16 Section 2. Notwithstanding the effective date 17 provisions of Act 2009-722, for the purposes of any qualifying 18 project for which an investing company filed a written 19 statement of intent as defined in Section 40-18-191, Code of 20 Alabama 1975, with the Department of Revenue on or before 21 November 21, 2009, the term "base wage requirement" as defined 22 in Section 40-18-190(a)(1)a. means the term "base wage 23 requirement" as defined in Section 40-18-190(a)(1) prior to the effective date of Act 2009-722. 24

Section 3. All laws or parts of laws which conflict
 with this act are repealed.
 Section 4. This act shall become effective

4 immediately following its passage and approval by the
5 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
