26	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

1 Section 1. (a) For purposes of this act, a secure 2 and verifiable document is a document issued by a state or federal jurisdiction or recognized by the United States 3 4 government and verifiable by federal or state law enforcement, 5 intelligence, or a homeland security agency. 6 (b) For purposes of this act, an individual is 7 unlawfully present in the United States if the individual is an alien who is not any of the following: 8 (1) A qualified alien as defined in 8 U.S.C. § 1641. 9 10 (2) A nonimmigrant under the federal Immigration and Nationality Act, Public Law 82-414, as amended. 11 12 (3) An alien who is paroled into the United States 13 under 8 U.S.C. § 1182(d)(5) for less than one year. 14 Section 2. Subject to the exemptions found in 8 15 U.S.C. § 1621(c)(2), to the extent that any license, permit, certificate, or other authorization to conduct business issued 16 17 to a person by the state or an agency or political subdivision of the state constitutes a professional license or commercial 18 license regulated by 8 U.S.C. § 1621, the license, permit, 19 20 certificate, or other authorization may be authorized, issued, 21 or renewed only if the person is lawfully and physically 22 present in the United States. Such authorization, issuance, or 23 renewal shall be immediately denied if the person is 24 determined to be unlawfully present in the United States. A 25 person shall prove his or her identity with a secure and 26 verifiable document. The state, agency, or political subdivision may not sell or utilize information contained in 27

1 the secure and verifiable document for any purpose other than 2 those specified in law and shall keep such information 3 confidential unless disclosure is otherwise required by law.

4 Section 3. Nothing in this act shall be construed 5 to limit public access to records that are available for 6 public inspection pursuant to Chapter 13 of Title 41, Code of 7 Alabama 1975.

8 Section 4. This act shall be enforced without regard 9 to race, religion, gender, ethnicity, or national origin.

10 Section 5. This act shall apply to issuances, 11 denials, renewals, and revocations of governmental 12 authorizations made on or after the effective date of this 13 act.

14 Section 6. This act shall become effective on the 15 first day of the third month following its passage and 16 approval by the governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
