2 ENROLLED, An Act, 3 Relating to Chambers County; authorizing the sale of draft or keg beer or malt beverages for only on-premises 4 5 consumption by properly licensed retail licensees of the 6 Alabama Alcoholic Beverage Control Board; and providing for a 7 referendum. 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA: Section 1. This act shall only apply to Chambers 9 10 County. 11 Section 2. Subject to the provisions of Section 4, 12 the sale of draft or keg beer or malt beverages for only 13 on-premises consumption by properly licensed retail licensees of the Alabama Alcoholic Beverage Control Board is authorized 14 15 in Chambers County. The Chambers County Commission may adopt 16 ordinances regulating the sale of draft or keg beer or malt beverages pursuant to this act. 17 18 Section 3. All laws or parts of laws which conflict 19 with this act are repealed. However, the provisions of this act are cumulative and supplementary and shall not be 20 21 construed to repeal or supersede any laws or parts of laws not 22 directly inconsistent herewith.

23 Section 4. Section 2 of this act shall become 24 operative only if approved by a majority of the qualified 25 electors of Chambers County who vote in an election to be held HB164

1 on the day of the first primary election in June 2010. The 2 question shall be, "Do you favor the adoption of Act No. , of the Session of the Alabama Legislature authorizing 3 the sale of draft or keg beer or malt beverages for only 4 5 on-premises consumption by retail licensees of the Alabama Alcoholic Beverage Control Board? Yes () No ()." The county 6 7 shall pay any costs and expenses not otherwise reimbursed by a 8 governmental agency which are incidental to the election. If a majority of the votes cast in the election are "Yes," Section 9 10 2 of this act shall become operative immediately. If the 11 majority of the votes are "No," this act shall be repealed and 12 shall have no further effect. The Judge of Probate of Chambers 13 County shall certify the results of the election to the Secretary of State. 14

Section 5. This act shall become effective
immediately following its passage and approval by the
Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
