1 Section 2. All laws or parts of laws which conflict
2 with this act are repealed. Act 181, 1957 Regular Session
3 (Acts 1957, p. 233), is specifically repealed.

4 Section 3. Sections 1 and 2 of this act shall become
5 operative only if approved by a majority of the qualified
6 electors of Mobile County who vote in an election to be held
7 on the day designated by the judge of probate. The notice of
8 the election shall be given by the judge of probate, and the
9 election shall be held, conducted, and the results canvassed
10 in the manner as other county elections. The election shall be
11 held in conjunction with the next regularly scheduled state or
12 local election to be held in the county. The question shall
13 be, "Do you favor the adoption of Act No. ___ of the 2010
14 Regular Session of the Alabama Legislature providing for the
15 election of county commission to be composed of five county
16 commissioners elected from single-member districts? Yes () No
17 ()." The county shall pay any costs and expenses not
18 otherwise reimbursed by a governmental agency which are
19 incidental to the election. If a majority of the votes cast in
20 the election are "Yes," Sections 1 and 2 of this act shall
21 become operative immediately. If the majority of the votes are
22 "No," this act shall be repealed and shall have no further
23 effect. The Judge of Probate of Mobile County shall certify
24 the results of the election to the Secretary of State.

1 Section 4. This act shall become effective
2 immediately following its passage and approval by the
3 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
