14 "Within five days after the arrest of any person for 15 violating <u>Section 9-13-60 or</u> any of such felony theft laws of the State of Alabama outlined in this article, the person 16 17 receiving possession of any vehicle and equipment, seized as aforesaid, shall report the seizure and detention of said the 18 vehicle and equipment to the district attorney or other 19 prosecuting official, giving a full description of such 20 21 vehicle and equipment, any identification number, make and 22 model thereof, the name of the person in whose possession it 23 was found when seized, the person, if any, making claim to same or any interest therein if the name can be ascertained or 24 25 is known, and the date and place of such the seizure and a statement of the circumstances surrounding the seizing of the 26 27 property.

2 "Within five days after the final conviction of any person for violating Section 9-13-60 or any of such felony 3 theft laws of the State of Alabama wherein timber or lumber 4 5 were items stolen, or intended to be stolen, involving timber or forest products or transactions pertaining thereto, the 6 7 person receiving possession of any vehicle and equipment, seized as aforesaid, shall report the seizure and detention of 8 said the vehicle and equipment to the district attorney or 9 10 other prosecuting official, giving a full description of such vehicle and equipment, any identification number, make and 11 12 model thereof, the name of the person in whose possession it 13 was found when seized, the person, if any, making claim to 14 same or any interest therein if the name can be ascertained or is known, and the date and place of such seizure and a 15 statement of the circumstances surrounding the seizing of the 16 17 property."

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
