21	Compact for Education (Act 227, HJR 42, 1949; Act 40, HJR 21,
22	1955) and those functions in Sections 16-3-32 through 16-3-35,
23	heretofore assigned to the State Board of Education with funds
24	that may be appropriated to it by the Legislature for that
25	purpose.

1	"(b) In addition to the function of the commission
2	pursuant to subsection (a) and supplemental thereto, the
3	commission may designate a portion of funds available for
4	chiropractic scholarships for advanced education in
5	health-related advanced education courses at the post-doctoral
6	level at public or private non-profit colleges and
7	universities within this state."
8	Section 2. This act shall become effective
9	immediately following its passage and approval by the
10	Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
