8 SYNOPSIS: This bill would prohibit the State of
9 Alabama, each municipality, and county from issuing
10 a license for the privilege of doing any kind of
11 business, trade, profession, or any other business
12 activity to any person who fails to present a valid
13 driver's license, a birth certificate, a passport,
14 or proof of citizenship or legal status in the
15 United States.

21 To prohibit the State of Alabama, each municipality,
22 and county from issuing a license for the privilege of doing
23 any kind of business, trade, profession, or any other business
24 activity to any person who fails to present a valid driver's
25 license, a birth certificate, a passport, or proof of
26 citizenship or legal status in the United States.

27 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

1 Section 1. The State of Alabama, each municipality,
2 and county may not issue a license for the privilege of doing
3 any kind of business, trade, profession, or any other business
4 activity to any person who fails to present a valid driver's
5 license, a birth certificate, a passport, or proof of
6 citizenship or legal status in the United States.

7 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
8 first day of the third month following its passage and
9 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
