12	Section 1. Section 11-90-2 of the Code of Alabama
13	1975, is amended to read as follows:
14	"§11-90-2.
15	"(a) The government and supervision of such
16	libraries shall be vested in a library board consisting of
17	five members who shall be appointed by the county commission
18	or the governing body of the municipality. The terms of
19	membership on the library board, as first appointed, for one
20	member shall be for one year, for the second member shall be
21	for two years, for the third member shall be for three years,
22	and for the remaining two members the terms shall be for four
23	years. After the first term, all appointments shall be for
24	four years. The county commission or governing body shall fill
25	all vacancies including expired and unexpired terms. Members
26	of the library board shall serve without compensation.

Т	"(b) After the effective date of the act adding this
2	subsection, the county commission of a county or governing
3	body of a municipality may appoint additional members to its
4	library board. The terms of any initial members appointed
5	pursuant to this subsection may be determined by the
6	appointing authority not to exceed four years. Thereafter, the
7	terms of all members may not exceed four years."
8	"(c) Subsection (b) does not apply in any county
9	where there exists a local library entity that does not govern
10	or administer public libraries and whose only function is to
11	distribute funds from a local sales tax."
12	"(d) The membership of the Library Boards shall be
13	inclusive and reflect the racial, gender, geographic,
14	urban/rural and economic diversity of the State. The Library
15	Boards shall annually report to the Alabama Public Library
16	Service and in turn they shall report to the Legislature by
17	the second legislative day of each regular session the extent
18	to which the Library Boards have complied with the diversity
19	provisions provided for in this act."
20	Section 2. This act shall become effective
21	immediately following its passage and approval by the
22	Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
