8 SYNOPSIS: This bill makes a supplemental  
9 appropriation in the amount of \$82,000,000 from the  
10 Mental Health Capital Improvement Fund to the  
11 Department of Mental Health for capital outlay for  
12 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010; a  
13 supplemental appropriation of \$1,750,000 to the  
14 Alabama Construction Recruitment Institute from the  
15 Recruitment and Training Promotion Fund for the  
16 fiscal year ending September 30, 2010; a  
17 supplemental appropriation of \$250,000 to the  
18 Department of Revenue from the Recruitment and  
19 Training Promotion Fund for the fiscal year ending  
20 September 30, 2010; a supplemental appropriation of  
21 \$155,000 to the Veterinary Medical Examiners Board  
22 from the Veterinary Medical Examiners Board fund  
23 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010; a  
24 supplemental appropriation of \$50,000 to the  
25 Securities Regulatory Board from the Security  
26 Certification Fund for the fiscal year ending  
27 September 30, 2010; and a supplemental

1 appropriation of \$120,000 to the Department of  
2 Insurance from the Reduced Cigarette Ignition  
3 Propensity Standards and Firefighter Protection Act  
4 Fund for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010.

5 This bill would also amend the fiscal year  
6 2010 General Appropriation Bill (Act 2009-550) by  
7 changing the funding source on the General  
8 Obligation Bonds, 1999 Series B, and on the General  
9 Obligation Parks Bonds, Series 2001-C, from the  
10 Capital Improvement Trust Fund to the State General  
11 Fund.

12 This bill would also amend Subsection 52 of  
13 Section 2C of Act 2009-550 to remove the General  
14 Fund Appropriation in its entirety for the fiscal  
15 year ending September 30, 2010.

21 To make a supplemental appropriation in the amount  
22 of \$82,000,000 from the Mental Health Capital Improvement Fund  
23 to the Department of Mental Health for capital outlay for the  
24 fiscal year ending September 30, 2010; a supplemental  
25 appropriation of \$1,750,000 to the Alabama Construction  
26 Recruitment Institute from the Recruitment and Training  
27 Promotion Fund for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010;

1 a supplemental appropriation of \$250,000 to the Department of  
2 Revenue from the Recruitment and Training Promotion Fund for  
3 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010; a supplemental  
4 appropriation of \$155,000 to the Veterinary Medical Examiners  
5 Board from the Veterinary Medical Examiners Board fund for the  
6 fiscal year ending September 30, 2010; a supplemental  
7 appropriation of \$50,000 to the Securities Regulatory Board  
8 from the Security Certification Fund for the fiscal year  
9 ending September 30, 2010; and a supplemental appropriation of  
10 \$120,000 to the Department of Insurance from the Reduced  
11 Cigarette Ignition Propensity Standards and Firefighter  
12 Protection Act Fund for the fiscal year ending September 30,  
13 2010.

14 To also amend the fiscal year 2010 General  
15 Appropriation Bill (Act 2009-550) by changing the funding  
16 source on the General Obligation Bonds, 1999 Series B, and on  
17 the General Obligation Parks Bonds, Series 2001-C, from the  
18 Capital Improvement Trust Fund to the State General Fund.

19 To also amend Subsection 52 of Section 2C of Act  
20 2009-550 to remove the General Fund Appropriation in its  
21 entirety for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

23 Section 1. In addition to all other appropriations,  
24 there is hereby appropriated \$82,000,000 from the Mental  
25 Health Capital Improvement Fund to the Department of Mental  
26 Health for capital outlay for the fiscal year ending September  
27 30, 2010.

1           Section 2. In addition to all other appropriations,  
2 there is hereby appropriated \$1,750,000 to the Alabama  
3 Construction Recruitment Institute from the Recruitment and  
4 Training Promotion Fund, pursuant to Act 09-561, for the  
5 fiscal year ending September 30, 2010.

6           Section 3. In addition to all other appropriations,  
7 there is hereby appropriated \$250,000 to the Department of  
8 Revenue from the Recruitment and Training Promotion Fund for  
9 the costs of administration and collection of revenues for the  
10 Alabama Construction Recruitment Institute pursuant to Act  
11 09-561, for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010.

12           Section 4. In addition to all other appropriations,  
13 there is hereby appropriated \$155,000 to the Veterinary  
14 Medical Examiners Board from the Veterinary Medical Examiners  
15 Board Fund for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010, for  
16 the one-time expenses of moving the administration offices of  
17 the Board from Decatur to Montgomery.

18           Section 5. In addition to all other appropriations,  
19 there is hereby appropriated \$50,000 from the Security  
20 Certification Fund to the Securities Regulatory Board for the  
21 fiscal year ending September, 30, 2010, pursuant to Act  
22 09-640.

23           Section 6. In addition to all other appropriations,  
24 there is hereby appropriated \$120,000 from the Reduced  
25 Cigarette Ignition Propensity Standards and Firefighter  
26 Protection Act Fund to the Department Of Insurance for the

1 fiscal year ending September, 30, 2010, pursuant to Act 09-630.

1                   Section 9. This act shall become effective  
2 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
3 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
