26	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

1	Section 1. Section 1-2-16, Code of Alabama 1975, is
2	amended to read as follows:
3	"§1-2-16.
4	"(a) The poem "Alabama," a gift to the people of the
5	state from Julia S. Tutwiler, together with the original music
6	written for such poem by Edna Gockel-Gussen, which music has
7	been approved and adopted by the Alabama Federation of Music
8	Clubs, is hereby adopted designated as the state song anthem
9	of Alabama.
10	"(b) The song "Stars Fell On Alabama" is hereby
11	designated as the state song of Alabama."
12	Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
13	first day of the third month following its passage and
14	approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
