BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

7 Section 1. In connection with the purchase of 8 material, equipment, or machinery for commercial fishing vessels described in subdivision (13) of subsection (a) of 9 Section 40-23-4, Code of Alabama 1975, and therefor exempt 10 11 from taxation under that section, the filing by the purchaser at retail of the material, equipment, or machinery with the 12 13 seller of a certificate in substantially the following form shall relieve the seller of any obligation to collect tax 14 15 under Chapter 23 of Title 40 with respect to the sales 16 described in that chapter:

Exemption certification respecting material, equipment, or machinery which, at any time, enters into and becomes a component part of commercial fishing vessels of over five tons load displacement as registered with the U.S. Coast Guard and licensed by the State of Alabama Department of Conservation and Natural Resources.
