10 (d) No county or municipality may provide by local 11 law or ordinance any prohibition, limitation, standard, or 12 other requirement relating to the inclusion of a bittering 13 agent in antifreeze or other engine coolant that is in any way 14 different from, or in addition to, this section.

(e) This section does not apply to either of thefollowing:

17 (1) The sale of a motor vehicle that contains18 antifreeze or another engine coolant.

(2) Wholesale containers of antifreeze and other
engine coolants containing 55 gallons or more of antifreeze or
engine coolant.
