2 ENROLLED, An Act, To amend Section 9-11-56.3 of the Code of Alabama 3 1975, relating to public pier fishing licenses and resident 4 5 saltwater pier fishing licenses; to authorize nonresidents to purchase a saltwater pier fishing license; and to change the 6 expiration date of public pier fishing licenses and saltwater 7 8 pier fishing licenses. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA: 9 Section 1. Section 9-11-56.3 of the Code of Alabama 10 11 1975, is amended to read as follows: "\$9-11-56.3. 12 13 "(a) A person, firm, or corporation that operates a 14 fishing pier open to the general public in the inside waters 15 of the State of Alabama as defined by Rule 220-3-.04 of the 16 Alabama Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, may 17 purchase a public fishing pier license to be issued by the 18 Marine Resources Division of the Department of Conservation 19 and Natural Resources. The fee for a public fishing pier license shall be one thousand dollars (\$1,000) per year. Any 20 21 law or regulation to the contrary notwithstanding, a resident 22 of the State of Alabama may fish from a licensed public 23 fishing pier in the inside waters of the State of Alabama 24 without purchasing a fishing license. A licensed public 25 fishing pier shall be open to the general public. This section shall not be construed to prohibit the operator of a licensed
 public fishing pier from charging a fee for the use of the
 pier.

"(b) A person who has been a bona fide resident of 4 5 this state for a period of not less than 90 days next preceding and who is age 16 through 64, may fish from piers 6 open to the general public in the Gulf of Mexico or the inside 7 8 waters of the State of Alabama as defined by Rule 220-3-.04 of the Alabama Department of Conservation and Natural Resources 9 by angling with rod and reel or by use of any artificial bait, 10 11 fly, or lure after purchasing an annual saltwater pier fishing license at a cost of five dollars (\$5). <u>A nonresident may fish</u> 12 13 from piers open to the general public in the Gulf of Mexico or the inside waters of the State of Alabama as defined by Rule 14 15 220-3-.04 of the Alabama Department of Conservation and 16 Natural Resources by angling with rod and reel or by use of any artificial bait, fly, or lure after purchasing an annual 17 18 saltwater pier fishing license at a cost of ten dollars (\$10). 19 Alabama residents and nonresidents possessing a current saltwater fishing license, and residents and nonresidents 20 21 under age 16, and over residents age 65 or over are expressly 22 exempt from the requirements of this subsection.

"(c) The licenses provided for in this section may
be purchased from any judge of probate, license commissioner,
revenue commissioner, or other officer authorized to issue

licenses upon application on forms furnished by the Division
 of Marine Resources of the Department of Conservation and
 Natural Resources and payment of the required fee for the
 license plus a one dollar (\$1) issuance fee.

5 "(d) The licenses provided for in this section shall 6 be issued on an annual basis and shall expire on <del>July</del> <u>August</u> 7 31 of each year.

8 "(e) Any revenue derived from the sale of these 9 licenses shall be remitted to the Department of Conservation 10 and Natural Resources on the first day of each month by the 11 issuing officer and shall be deposited in the State Treasury 12 to the credit of the Marine Resources Fund.

13 "(f) Any violation of this section shall be a Class 14 C misdemeanor punishable as provided by law except that the 15 minimum fine shall not be less than fifty dollars (\$50). In 16 addition, the punishment for a violation of subsection (a) of 17 this section shall include an additional mandatory fine of 18 twice the amount of the license."

19Section 2. This act shall become effective June 1,202010.
