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2 <u>ENROLLED</u>, An Act,

To alter or rearrange the boundary lines of the City of Monroeville, Monroe County, Alabama, so as to include within the corporate limits of said City all territory now within such corporate limits and also certain territory contiguous thereto, in Monroeville, Monroe County, Alabama. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1. That the boundary lines of the City of 10 Monroeville, Monroe County, Alabama be, and the same are 11 hereby altered or rearranged so as to include all of the 12 territory heretofore encompassed by the corporate limits of 13 the City of Monroeville, and in addition thereto the following 14 described territory, to-wit:

15 A tract of land containing 5.42 acres, more or less, 16 located in the North half of Section 22, Township 7 North, Range 7 East, Monroe County, Alabama, said 5.42 acre tract 17 18 being apart of the Raymond and Thomas Broughton Property 19 according to a deed recorded in Deed Book 714, Page 205, in the Probate Office of Monroe County, Alabama, this survey is 20 21 referenced to the plat of the Limestone Bridge project as 22 recorded in the Alabama Department of Transportation District 23 8 Office in Grove Hill, Alabama and bearings are oriented to 24 the centerline of Alabama Hwy No. 41 as shown on same, said 25 5.42 acre tract being more particularly described, as follows

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to-wit: Commencing at a capped rebar found (CRF STERN) guarded 1 by a steel fence post (SP) at the previously established SW 2 corner of the NW of NE 1/4, said point measures North 3 89°26'22" East 2692.04 feet and South 0°33'38" East 1336.49 4 5 feet from a painted line intersection locally accepted as being the NW corner of said Section 22, said point is also on 6 the locally accepted West line of the Broughton Property; 7 8 thence South 88°57'56" West 149.92 feet along said West line to a CRF (STERN); thence North 1°51'05" West 113.37 feet along 9 traces of old fence and said West line to a capped rebar set 10 11 (CRS 3906) & SP at the Point of True Beginning; thence 12 continuing along said West line (Along an old property line 13 fence) for the following: North 1°51'05" West 100.0 feet to a CRS at a fence corner; thence North 52°02'46" West 56.74 feet 14 to a CRS at a fence corner; thence South 71°37'34" West 97.81 15 16 feet to a CRS at a fence corner; thence North 22°14'37" West 79.41 feet to a bend; thence North 13°26'33" West 138.76 feet 17 18 to a bend' thence North 3°02'45" West 112.25 feet to a bend; 19 thence North 8°40'18" East 268.10 feet to a CRS near a fence corner, said point is the Northern most corner of the 20 21 Broughton Property, said point is also on the SW margin of 22 Alabama Hwy 41 (24' Bit. Pvmt. R.O.W. VARIES); thence South 23 40°01'31" East 68.68 feet along said SW margin to a Concrete 24 Monument Found (CMF) (It being noted that this point was shown as the Broughton Northern most corner of the Limestone Creek 25

1 bridge Project Plans); thence South 40°57'55" East 229.89 feet 2 along said SW margin to a CMF (R.O.W.); thence North 49°58'29" East 10.77 feet along said SW margin to a CRS; thence South 3 40°01'31" East 188.50 feet along said SW margin to a CRS & SP, 4 said point measures North 40°01'31" West 41.82 feet from a CMF 5 (R.O.W.) said point is also the North most corner of Tract No. 6 2; thence leaving said SW margin South 26°56'29" West 587.96 7 8 feet along the North line of said Tract No. 2 to the Point of 9 Beginning.

Section 2. A map showing the territory proposed to be annexed is on file in the office of the judge of probate in Monroe County. This map is open to public inspection.

Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon its
passage and approval by the Governor, or upon its otherwise
becoming a law.
