ENROLLED, An Act,

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, relating to Randolph County; to provide that the moneys paid into the Randolph County Capital Improvement Fund pursuant to Amendment 668 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 219.05 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, may be expended for economic development projects.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of this act are fulfilled:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Moneys paid into the Randolph County Capital Improvement Fund pursuant to Amendment 668 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 219.05 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, may be expended for economic development projects.

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Amendment 555 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of

1 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this state.

2 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall  
3 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional  
4 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the  
5 following description of the substance or subject matter of  
6 the proposed constitutional amendment:

7 "Relating to Randolph County, proposing an amendment  
8 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to provide that the  
9 moneys paid into the Randolph County Capital Improvement Fund  
10 pursuant to Amendment 668 of the Constitution of Alabama of  
11 1901, now appearing as Section 219.05 of the Official  
12 Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as  
13 amended, may be expended for economic development projects
