19	Section 1. This act shall apply only in Jefferson

24	executing an appeal bond, supersedeas bond, dissolution bond,

failure to file said bond shall not deprive Jefferson County of the right of entry pending said appeal.

Section 3. In all cases in which Jefferson County desires to take an appeal to another Court, to which appeals are allowable, the same may be effected by filing in the Court wherein such judgment, decree, writ or order was entered, a statement by any County Attorney of such County to the effect that such County takes an appeal to the Court, designating in the blank space the name and style of the Court to which the appeal is taken; and when such statement is signed and filed by such County Attorney in the Court wherein such judgment, decree, writ or order was entered within the time allowed by law for taking an appeal in such case, this shall have the effect of appealing the case and superseding any such judgment, decree, writ or order, as fully as if a good and sufficient supersedeas bond or right of entry bond in condemnation proceedings or any other bond. In condemnation proceedings, where an appeal is perfected as set out above, Jefferson County shall have the immediate right of entry pending said appeal as if a good and sufficient bond had been filed.

Section 4. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
