To require public institutions of higher education to interview minority candidates when hiring an athletic director or a head coach for any sport sponsored by the institution unless the institution is bound by contract to promote a member of the current coaching staff.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) For purposes of this section, a public institution of higher education includes public two-year and four-year institutions of higher education and postsecondary technical colleges, community colleges, and junior colleges located in the state.

(b) Each public institution of higher education shall interview one or more minority applicants when hiring an athletic director or head coach, unless the institution is bound by contract to promote a member of the institution's current coaching staff.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
