Section 1. Members of the board of trustees, the executive committee of the board of trustees, or any other committee established by the board of trustees of any public four-year institution of higher education located in this state may participate in a meeting of the board or committee by means of telephone conference, video conference, or similar communications equipment by means of which all persons participating in the meeting may hear each other at the same time. Participation by such means shall constitute presence in person at a meeting for all purposes, including the establishment of a quorum. Notice of such meetings shall be provided in accordance with the Alabama Open Meetings Act and such telephone or video conference or similar communications equipment shall also allow members of the public the opportunity to simultaneously listen to or observe such meetings.

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
