to require a new or increased expenditure of local

Although this bill would have as its 14 purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased 15 expenditure of local funds, the bill is excluded from further requirements and application under Amendment 621, now 16 17 appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of 18 the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, because the 19 Legislative Fiscal Office has determined the bill has an aggregate fiscal impact of less than \$50,000 annually. 20 21 Section 4. This act shall become effective on the 22 first day of the third month following its passage and 23 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
