BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

2 Section 1. The following amendment to the 3 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become 4 valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of 5 this act are fulfilled:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

7 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, at the next election following redistricting of the county 8 commission districts as provided in subsection (b), the 9 10 Jefferson County Commission shall be comprised of four members elected to terms of four years from single-member districts 11 12 and a chair elected to a term of four years from the county 13 at-large. Each commissioner shall be a resident of the 14 district from which he or she is elected and the chair of the 15 commission shall be a resident of Jefferson County. The chair shall preside over meetings of the commission, but shall not 16 17 vote except in the case of a tie vote.

(b) Immediately after the population figures from 18 the federal decennial census compiled for 2010 are released by 19 20 the federal government, the Jefferson County Commission shall 21 adopt a plan dividing the county into four county commission 22 districts approximately of equal population as provided by 23 law. The districts shall be operable for the next general election following the release of the 2010 census population 24 25 figures. The districts shall be adopted according to the same procedures set out in Section 11-3-1.1, Code of Alabama 1975. 26

1 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment 2 shall be held in accordance with Amendment 555 to the 3 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 4 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of 5 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this 6 state.

Section 3. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the following description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed constitutional amendment:

12 "Relating to Jefferson County, proposing an 13 amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to further 14 provide for the districts for the election of the county 15 commission and to provide for the election of a chair of the 16 county commission from the county at-large.
