8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, the Birmingham City
9 Council is comprised of nine members elected from
10 nine districts.

11 This bill would propose a local
12 constitutional amendment relating to the City of
13 Birmingham to provide that the city council would
14 be comprised of nine members. Eight members would
15 be elected from districts and one member, a
16 president, would be elected at-large; and would
17 provide for the redistricting for the election of
18 the Birmingham City Council based on the 2010
19 federal decennial census.

21 A BILL
22 TO BE ENTITLED

25 Proposing a local constitutional amendment to the
26 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, relating to the City of
27 Birmingham; to provide for the districts for the election of

1 the Birmingham City Council; to provide for the election for a
2 President of the Birmingham City Council to be elected
3 at-large.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

5 Section 1. The following amendment to the
6 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become
7 valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of
8 this act are fulfilled:

9 PROPOSED AMENDMENT

10 (a) At the next election following redistricting of
11 the city council districts as provided in subsection (b), the
12 Birmingham City Council shall be comprised of eight members
13 elected to terms of four years from single-member districts
14 and a president elected to a term of four years from the city-
15 at-large. Each city council member shall be a resident of the
16 district from which he or she is elected and the president of
17 the council shall be a resident of the City of Birmingham. The
18 president shall preside over meetings of the council, but
19 shall not vote except in the case of a tie vote.

20 (b) Immediately after the population figures from
21 the federal decennial census compiled for 2010 are released by
22 the federal government, the Birmingham City Council shall
23 adopt a plan dividing the county into eight districts
24 approximately of equal population as provided by law. The
25 districts shall be operable for the next general election
26 following the release of the 2010 census population figures.

1 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
2 shall be held in accordance with Amendment 555 to the
3 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section
4 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of
5 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this
6 state.

7 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall
8 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional
9 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the
10 following description of the substance or subject matter of
11 the proposed constitutional amendment:

12 "Relating to the City of Birmingham, proposing an
13 amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to provide
14 for the districts for the election of eight members of the
15 Birmingham City Council and to provide for the president of
16 the council to be elected at-large.

17 "Proposed by Act _____."

18 This description shall be followed by the following
19 language:
