Although this bill would have as its 14 purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased 15 expenditure of local funds, the bill is excluded from further requirements and application under Amendment 621, now 16 17 appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of 18 the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, because the 19 bill defines a new crime or amends the definition of an existing crime. 20

21 Section 6. This act shall become effective 22 immediately following its passage and approval by the 23 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
