2.7	landfill, a solid waste landfill, a hazardous waste landfill,

or an industrial landfill, or new junk yard as defined in 1 Section 11-80-10 of the Code of Alabama 1975, shall be 2 established on any property located within one mile of the 3 Chattahoochee River. This section may be enforced by injunctive relief in the circuit court of the county where a 5 6 violation occurs. Notwithstanding the foregoing, nothing in 7 this section shall apply to any landfill or junk yard located on-site at an industrial facility. 8 Section 2. All laws or parts of laws which conflict 9 10 with this act are repealed. Section 3. This act shall become effective 11 12 immediately following its passage and approval by the 13 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
