2 ENROLLED, An Act,

3 Relating to Lauderdale County; to amend Section 1 of
4 Act 800 of the 1975 Special Session (Acts 1975, p. 1604),
5 relating to supplementing the salary or compensation paid to
6 semi-retired or retired circuit judges of the 11th Judicial
7 Circuit; to prohibit supplementing the salaries or
8 compensation of a semi-retired or retired circuit judge who
9 has not vested in the Retirement Systems of Alabama; and to
10 provide that the supplement received by each circuit judge who
11 has vested in the Retirement Systems of Alabama shall be paid
12 pursuant to the formula as provided in Act 800.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

14 Section 1. Section 1 of Act 800 of the 1975 Special
15 Session (Acts 1975, p. 1604) is amended to read as follows:

16 "(a) Any semi-retired or retired circuit judge in
17 the 11th Judicial Circuit shall be entitled to receive as
18 additional compensation payable from the treasury of the
19 county, a sum equal to one and one half percent of the
20 compensation paid said judge by the State of Alabama for each
21 year served as circuit judge up to a maximum of 25 percent.
22 The salaries or compensation provided for herein is
23 supplementary to the salaries or compensation paid the judges
24 by the state and shall be paid out of the general funds of the

1 county in twelve equal monthly installments on warrants
2 properly drawn against the funds.

3 "(b) The additional compensation may not be paid to
4 a semi-retired or retired circuit judge who has not vested in
5 the Retirement Systems of Alabama as of the date of the
6 enactment of this act.

7 "(c) Each circuit judge receiving a retirement
8 supplement pursuant to this act and who has vested in the
9 Retirement Systems of Alabama shall receive a retirement
10 supplement pursuant to the formula provided in subsection
11 (a)."

12 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
13 first day of the third month following its passage and
14 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
