1	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
2	Section 1. Section 34-25-22, Code of Alabama 1975,
3	is amended to read as follows:
4	"\$34-25-22.
5	"(a) Applications for original license shall be made
6	to the board in writing under oath on forms prescribed by the
7	board and shall be accompanied by the required fee a fee of
8	one hundred fifty dollars (\$150), which is not refundable. Any
9	such application shall require such information as in the
10	judgment of the board will enable it to pass on the
11	qualifications of the applicant for a license.
12	"(b) A state and national criminal history
13	background information check shall be conducted by the Alabama
14	Department of Public Safety and the Federal Bureau of
15	Investigation on all applicants seeking an original license by
16	the board.
17	"(c) The request to the board shall contain the
18	following information:
19	"(1) Two complete functional sets of fingerprints,
20	either cards or electronic, properly executed by a criminal
21	justice agency or an individual properly trained in
22	fingerprinting techniques.
23	"(2) Written consent from the applicant for the
24	release of criminal history background information to the
25	board.
26	"(3) A nonrefundable fee to be paid to the board in
27	an amount of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150)."

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
