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2 ENROLLED, An Act,

3 Relating to Etowah County; to provide for the
4 payment into the Sheriff's Law Enforcement Fund certain monies
5 received by the county commission and paid over to the fund;
6 and to provide for retroactive effect.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

8 Section 1. In Etowah County, there is currently
9 being paid by the Etowah County Commission to the Sheriff's
10 Law Enforcement Fund created by Act 87-644, 1987 Regular
11 Session (Acts 1987, p. 1149), a portion of certain monies
12 received by the Etowah County Commission from U. S.
13 Immigration and Customs Enforcement.

14 Section 2. Any and all monies paid to the Sheriff's
15 Law Enforcement Fund from sources identified in Section 1
16 shall continue to be paid to the fund and used in a manner
17 consistent with the uses provided for by Act 87-644.

18 Section 3. All laws or parts of laws which conflict
19 with this act are repealed.

20 Section 4. The provisions of this act are severable.
21 If any part of this act is declared invalid or
22 unconstitutional, that declaration shall not affect the part
23 which remains.

24 Section 5. This act shall be retroactive to fiscal
25 year beginning October 1, 2004, and any payments by the county

1 commission to the Sheriff's Law Enforcement Fund and any
2 expenditures by the sheriff in accordance with this act are
3 hereby validated and confirmed.
